JLVC Mini CME Series - Learning #1

Laser Ablative Refractive surgery (LASIK) is now a very safe and highly predictable form of Refractive Correction. The awareness about Lasik and its place as an equal if not better alternative to other forms of vision correction, is very clear to those who prefer a lifestyle change. With many centres offering quality Lasik Surgery in Bangalore, isn't it high time you included this in your Bouquet of services? Lasik Surgery may not require any investment, but just an association with a Good Lasik Centre. This will be followed by a Case Scenario Session where actual 'Dilemmas in Case Selection' will be presented and discussed. Opinions about these cases obtained from Lasik Surgeons from across the country (We are in touch with Dr. Prema Padmabhan, Dr. Srinivas Rao, Dr. Rajesh Fogla, Dr. Wavikar) will be presented. While case selection criteria are available in most textbooks, Intelligent case rejection comes with accumulated experience. This course aims to highlight these experiences. The course will continue into the second part with a programmed panel discussion, by experts with years of experience to lead towards clear 'take home' messages. It is our hope that the audience brings their queries, experiences, suggestions, tips and tricks so that it will be a collective learning for all.
